Expectations for Performers & Their Families 2024

To put on any production, especially after taking two years off for a pandemic, takes heart, determination, practice, skill, and...money. Durham Ballet Theatre does not charge a participation fee to our performers, instead we ask you to support the show in the following ways:

- Cast Meeting: Sunday, January 14, 2024 from 2:30p-4:30p

- Rehearsals begin January 20, 2024 !! DO NOT MISS REHEARSAL !!

We understand emergencies happen but all performers are expected to attend all rehearsals. Spring break is March 25 - 31, 2024. There will be no rehearsals this week.

- Costume Rental Fee: Due January 30, 2023

Costume Rental between \$85 - \$400 depending upon casting and number of scenes.

examples of cost: cast as Flower Fairy \$85, cast as Fairy \$110, cast in 2 roles with wig \$200

Your Costume Rental fee not only covers use of the required costume(s)* but also provides the following benefits:

18-36+ hours of experience executing choreography

Exposure to and ability to participate on crews for costume designs, set design, and construction

Experience with sales and working with the public

Each cast member receives 1 ticket for each performance on Saturday in general seating.

Use of studio space (based on availability) to run through choreography

If the costume or any part of the costume is lost, stolen or damaged by the performer or anyone else, you must pay the full replacement value is more than the rental fee of the costume to Durham Ballet Theatre at the rates stated below.

Replacement Value: \$150 - \$1000 dependent upon costume.

-Volunteer

- Sell Advertisement

Deadline for ads and payment is Sunday, April 7, 2024

- Ticket Sales

Sell at least Ten (10) tickets to the May performances per family

General Seating: Tickets between \$15 - \$25 each Advance Sales Discount: 15% on General Seating

Reserved Seating: \$35-\$55

- -If you would prefer to make one payment, a minimum donation of \$500 will cover all obligations
- Worried about selling 10 performance tickets, you can sell 4 ads instead
- By selling additional performance tickets and/or ads you can cover the cost of costume rental

If you are unable to commit to the rehearsal schedule please reconsider if this is a good time for you to be in a performance.

Telling someone in the hallway is <u>not</u> adequate notification. Please inform Durham Ballet Theatre by email as soon as you know you will miss rehearsal.

Each performer is responsible for learning and executing choreography at the standards upheld by DBT. Please be aware that if you are having difficulty learning or executing choreography, you WILL be asked to participate in classes that are in addition to regular rehearsal times.

Rehearsals for this show must be your priority if you wish to participate!

Please consider whether or not you can make this commitment.
